The Hebrew people <u>complained</u> about how bad their lives were as slaves in Egypt.	God helped Moses convince the Pharaoh to let the Hebrew people go free by sending 10 different plagues.
The Hebrew people were freed from slavery and quickly fled, leaving so quickly they didn't even have time for their bread to finish rising.	Pharaoh's army chased the Hebrews to the Red Sea. The Hebrews <u>complained</u> they were trapped and would be killed.
God answers Moses' prayer by providing water flowing from a rock for everyone to drink.	The Hebrew people began <u>complaining</u> of hunger while wandering around in the wilderness.
God answered Moses' prayer by providing manna and quail for everyone to eat.	The Hebrew people <u>complained</u> they were thirsty and blamed Moses for bringing them into the desert.
God helped Moses part the Red Sea so that the Hebrew people could escape Pharaoh's army by walking across. Once all Hebrews made it safely across, the waters came crashing down on Pharaoh's army.
